Having thoroughly reviewed the profiles and required consultations of the shortlisted experts for their expertise, experience and reputation, considering the importance of the jury's role in the evaluation and selection process, the Leadership and Advisory Committee, meeting in session on August 9, 2026, appointed, by Resolution No. 03/CPMA/LAC/2026 adopted unanimously, the eight (8) experts listed below, with Mr. Kom Franck Gérard as Chair.



Franck Gérard KOM

Chair of the Judging Committee

Expert and director with over twenty years of experience in telecommunications, oil, the public sector, and IT consulting, he recently served as Managing Director of the Enterprise Business Unit at MTN Cameroon, where he led large-scale digital transformations. A pioneer of project management in Africa, co-founder and former President of the PMI Cameroon Chapter, he was the first CAPM-certified professional in Cameroon. He holds PMP and PMI-RMP certifications, and completed Executive Education programs at Wharton and Columbia Business School.



Ernest NNANGA

Member of the Judging Committee

A project management expert and statistician-economist engineer (ENSEA, 2003) by training, with over twenty years of experience in foresight, strategic planning and monitoring-evaluation of public policies. Head of the Foresight and Strategic Planning Division at MINEPAT, he leads the national technical coordination for the monitoring and evaluation of the SND30 and Vision 2035. He chairs the Technical Committee ANOR/CT14 in project, programme et portfolio management and sits on the Steering Committee of CARPA. He is PMP and PMO-CP certified.
